Santa Fe Rehab Project 10-046

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting July 28, 2010, 1:30 pm

Attendees: Please see attached sign-up sheet

Kim Swearingen, the project manager, opened the meeting at 1:30p.m. Kim requested that all questions regarding this project be to her by 1:00 p.m. Thursday July 29th because she will be absent next week prior to bid opening.

Bid opening for this project will be Wednesday, August 4th at 1:00. Kim reminded everyone that they need to be a licensed business within the City of Pueblo. The contractor who is awarded the bid will have to pay sales tax on all material and also have to pay a use tax on all vehicles and equipment used on this project.

Kim pointed out that if anyone had any questions about manholes they could find a spec sheet in the Design Criteria Manual online at www.pueblo.us under the Public Works tab.

The main in Santa Fe is very large and the Wastewater Department has no flow information but the pipe is flowing at approximately design flow. You need to have your bypass plan ready by the pre-construction meeting and Kim will be handing out the notice to proceed during the pre-construction meeting so you will need to bring a schedule of work.

This project is funded by a State Tribal Assistance Grant and Kim had Meg Scarlett remind everyone that they need to try and use minority and women owned businesses. The Grant is requiring a lot of documentation regarding the minority and women owned businesses and also environmental protection agency. All forms will be required to be filled out after the project is awarded and some reports will be filed throughout the entire contract. No Davis Bacon for this project.

Kim pointed out that there are two sites (1) Ilex north to 4th Street, (2) 4th Street north to 6th. On pages 9 and 15 of the plans you will see the same manhole is counted in both sites so the quantities were based on that manhole being counted twice. At manhole 505275.7 there is two different sizes. They are to bid the 72" manhole size.

A question during the meeting was if they could break out the manhole sizes as different line items? Kim instructed them that it saved on calculations from the City perspective and it would remain as a lump sum.

The mandatory pre-bid sign-up sheet and meeting minutes will be sent to everyone present by this afternoon via e-mail. Everyone was encouraged to meet at the intersection of Grand and Santa Fe to go over any on-site questions.
